

English language development for teachers and staff working in education- level A1/A2

Course Outline

- This course is aimed at non-native teachers and educational staff who are interested in developing their English language skills to be able to communicate more effectively. Participants will be able to upgrade their level of English through a variety of interactive activities in the classroom. This course also includes a focus on language skills.

The aim of this course is to

- Language awareness: exploring and building up lexical and grammatical areas.
- Developing the four language skills: listening, speaking, reading and writing.
- Communication skills: gaining confidence and fluency.
- Phonology: working on stress, rhythm, intonation and phonetic sounds and symbols.

Activities

- Language Development Sessions: Engage in activities aimed at enhancing general English proficiency towards an A2 level, fostering confidence in language use.
- Practical Activities for Critical Thinking: Participate in various practical exercises designed to promote critical thinking skills within an English language context.
- Phonology Exploration: Delve into the sounds of English through workshops focusing on stress, rhythm, intonation, and phonetic symbols, enhancing language comprehension and pronunciation..

Outcomes

- enhance knowledge of general English
- working towards an A2 level.
- have the opportunity to practise English and
- gain confidence in using the language.
- engage in a number of practical activities that
- encourage critical thinking.
- explore the sounds of English.
