We will enhance the four bases of the language: speaking, reading, listening, and writing, through dynamic activities with a special focus on oral communication and simple conversations useful for daily and professional life.

Understand and produce basic English in everyday contexts.

Engage in simple conversations using basic grammatical structures.

Identify key information in spoken interactions and short, simple texts.

Develop a basic vocabulary and gain insight into everyday aspects of English-speaking cultures.

## DAILY PROGRAM

<b>Day 1</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Welcome meeting and introductions</li><li>• Fears and expectations</li><li>• Introduction of the course and presentations</li><li>• English language course: Basic greetings and introductions, Sharing personal information, Useful phrases for starting a conversation; English pronunciation: common challenges</li></ul>
<b>Day 2</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• English language course: Describing your day and schedule; Talking about daily activities; Common verbs and useful expressions; Asking and answering simple questions</li></ul>
<b>Day 3</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Visit to an educational centre (depending on mobility)</li><li>• English language course: Spanish education system; Follow-up reflection: compare the differences with your own country</li></ul>
<b>Day 4</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• English language course: Food and drinks: understanding a restaurant menu, ordering and writing a recipe; Spanish food culture; Talking about likes and dislikes; Table manners</li></ul>
<b>Day 5</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• English language course: Talking about plans and future actions; Review of key vocabulary and structures; Role-playing everyday situations; Debate: current events and controversial issues</li><li>• Final meeting for final evaluation of the training</li></ul>
