We will enhance the four bases of the language: speaking, reading, listening, and writing, through dynamic activities with a special focus on oral communication and simple conversations useful for daily and professional life.

Understand and produce basic Spanish in everyday contexts.

Engage in simple conversations using basic grammatical structures.

Identify key information in spoken interactions and short, simple texts in Spanish.

Develop a basic vocabulary and gain insight into everyday aspects of Spanish-speaking cultures.

DAILY PROGRAM

Day 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Welcome meeting and introductions• Fears and expectations• Introduction of the course and presentations• Spanish language course: Greetings and introductions; Expressing basic personal information; First useful phrases for everyday situations; Pronunciation: tips for non-Spanish speakers
Day 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Spanish language course: Talking about the weather and days of the week; Understanding the present simple; Asking and answering simple questions; Numbers: prices and more
Day 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Visit to an educational centre (depending on mobility)• Spanish language course: Spanish education system; Follow-up reflection: compare the differences with your own country
Day 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Spanish language course: Describing yourself and others; Talking about daily activities and hobbies; Likes and dislikes; Moving around the city: asking and giving simple directions
Day 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Spanish language course: Talking about food and drinks; Spanish food culture and traditions; Review of key vocabulary and structures• Final meeting for final evaluation of the training
