DAILY PROGRAM

Day 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Welcome meeting and introductions• Fears and expectations• Introduction of the course and presentations• English language course: Giving personal information; Understanding and writing about personal details; Pronunciation practice and tongue twisters: recognising accents
Day 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• English language course: Describing a day in your life: present and past; Speculating and creating conditional sentences; Common idioms and applications; Talking about hobbies; How to write an email
Day 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Visit to an educational centre (depending on mobility)• English language course: Spanish education system; Follow-up reflection: compare the differences with your own country
Day 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• English language course: Talking about food and drinks: ordering and receiving information; Typically Spanish; World food culture: understanding the importance of food; Recipe preparation: how to write a recipe
Day 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• English language course: Future: how to make plans; Role playing activity: daily life scenarios; Debate: final discussion• Final meeting for final evaluation of the training
